## PLACEMENT DECISIONS FOR CHILDREN IN CUSTODY

## **POLICY**

All placement decisions are made to meet the best interest of the child in custody.

## **PROCEDURE**

- A. Parameters for ALL placement decisions:
  - 1. Meet the child's needs in the least restrictive environment.
  - 2. Give first consideration to agency-licensed foster homes.
  - 3. Never exceed a facility's license capacity.
  - 4. Place siblings together when appropriate.
  - 5. Only consider appropriately-licensed facilities.
  - 6. Examine caregiver's ability to meet child's needs--culturally, environmentally, physically, and emotionally.
  - 7. Before placing a child in a "borrowed" foster home, group home, or other licensed facility, attempt to make a prior on-site evaluation.
- B. Staff involved in initial placement and placement change decisions:
  - 1. Child's worker and/or supervisor.
  - 2. Foster care worker.
  - 3. Adoption worker--if permanent custody is imminent.
  - 4. Placement Services Unit Supervisor.
  - 5. Social Service Department Head--if permanent custody is imminent.

**NOTE:** In emergency situations, a Social Service Worker 3, in consultation with a Children Services supervisor, may be the only staff involved in placement decisions.
