Who can become a foster parent?

- You must be at least 18 years of age.
- You must be able to communicate with the child, agency, health care and service providers
- You can be married, single, divorced or widowed. All orientations.
- At least one applicant must have functional literacy to read and write at a level necessary to participate effectively in the community in which they live.
- All religious affiliations are acceptable.
- Your household must have enough income to make timely payments for shelter, food, utility costs, clothing, and other household expenses prior to the addition of a child in foster care.
- You do not have to own a home but must have enough space available for foster children if you rent.
