## USE OF PLAY EQUIPMENT

## A. General Rules for Use of Play Equipment

- 1. Children are to be attended by an adult at all times.
- 2. Children should be dressed appropriately for play.
- 3. Do not use equipment when wet or ice-covered.
- 4. Children are to use only the equipment designed for their age group.
- 5. No rough-housing while on or around the equipment.
- 6. Report any broken equipment immediately to an agency supervisor.
- 7. Any accidents occurring while playing on or around the equipment are to be reported immediately to an agency supervisor.

## B. Specific Rules for Use of Play Equipment

- 1. Children must have permission from an agency worker before using the play equipment.
- 2. Children are to be in sight of the family service aide at all times. No hiding in the pine trees.
- 3. Do not throw or remove the surface materials.
- 4. Only children are to swing on the swings and utilize the play equipment.
- 5. Children must sit in the center of the swing seat; no standing, kneeling, or lying across the seat.
- 6. Only one child is allowed on a swing at a time.
- 7. Children must hold on with both hands.
- 8. Children are not to push other children on the swings.
- 9. All children swinging must be facing the same direction.
- 10. No jumping on or off a moving swing.
- 11. Do not approach a moving swing or stand in its path.
- 12. Do not fwist the swing chains.
- 13. Do not swing empty swings.
- 14. Toddlers in the bucket swing must be attended by an adult at all times.
- 15. No climbing, standing, or playing on the swing set frame.
